



INVITATION FOR BIDS

TENDERS FOR THE PROVISION OF AIR TRAVEL AND CLEANING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR

- 1.0 The Judiciary has made budgetary allocation in its 2017 budget for the provision of air travel and cleaning services for a period of one year and therefore intends to enter into a long term contracts. The Judiciary is now looking for firms to participate in the under listed tenders:

 - Tender for the provision of Cleaning services at the Supreme and Commercial Courts buildings – JUD/S/03/2017
- 2.0 The Judiciary now invites sealed bids from eligible firms to bid for the tenders.
- 3.0 Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method. The tender has a Preferential Procurement Clause for bidders registered with the Citizen Economic Empowerment Commission (CEEC) in line with ZPPA circular No. 2 of 2011 as follows:
- (a) For a citizen influenced company, by four percent (4%)
 - (b) For a citizen-empowered company, by eight percent (8%)
 - (c) For a citizen- owned company, by twelve percent (12%)
